

CAVRINE

Red Veneto wine, regional geographic indication

Produced on the Falcona morainic hills in a plot of land named "Cavrine", where the name tells of land once held to be too poor for crops and left as pasture for goats. Today, thanks to modern vineyard layouts, it generates excellent grapes for vinification, bringing special organoleptic properties to the wine.

Grapes: Corvina, Rondinella, Sangiovese e Molinara.

Vinification: fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks. Refinement for 12 months in oak barrels and then another 6 months in the bottle.

Characteristics: red wine with supple structure and a bouquet that reminds us of ripe blackcurrants and blackberries.

Alcohol content: 13% by volume.

Services: serve at a temperature of 18°.

Format: 0.75 liter Bordeaux bottle
